ATTENTION!!! READ IMMEDIATELY!!!

- If you take blood thinners (Anticoagulants) like Heparin, Coumadin, Plavix and any ASPIRIN product, such as Aspirin, Ecotrin, Motrin, Advil, Aleve etc., you must discontinue their use ONE WEEK prior to the procedure.
- 2. If you need medication for pain relief, you may take Acetaminophen (Tylenol).
- 3. If your procedure is scheduled between 09:00 AM and 12:00 PM you may bring your medications with you. If your procedure is scheduled for after 12:00 PM you may take your medications in the morning before coming to the hospital (only if you are scheduled for a colonoscopy).
- 4. Please notify our office IMMEDIATELY if you have an artificial heart valve or history of pericarditis.
- 5. If you are DIABETIC, see info in the next page.

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- 6. You must have a driver with you to bring you home after the procedure. A taxi is only acceptable if you have another adult with you beside the taxi driver.
- 7. It is important that you fill the Millard Fillmore Suburban registration sheet that you get from our office and take it with you to the hospital the day of the procedure.
